Celebration of Achievements - Music & Art

Description

Rotary International seeks to promote the musical, artistic, and communication skills of young people, and sponsors activities in partnership with schools, colleges and youth organisations, which gives opportunities for these talents to be recognised.

Activities include:

- a competition to find the Young Musician of the Year
- a non-competitive concert involving the full age range 8 to 18 called 'Schools (or Youth) Make Music'
- Competitive or otherwise, events should be taken seriously, but be FUN!

Age

8-18 years.

Junior and secondary age groups, 8-11 years and 12-18 years.

Cost

Possible entrance fee. Prizes, awards and certificates provided by Rotary club(s) or sponsors. Rotary clubs arrange venue, and undertake administration.

Insurance

Covered by school and youth organisation.

Organisation

Three rounds including final, when winner and runners-up are selected and prizes and certificates presented.

Concert includes variety of vocal and instrumental playing, given by soloists, duets, and groups; performed before an invited audience. Memento or certificate presented to each performer.
