## FROM TIP TO SHIP WITH START

**CLOSING DATE FOR COMPETITION**  
**16<sup>th</sup> April 2012**



**Start Imagining: an exciting new  
creative craft project for young people**

Entitled 'From Tip To Ship', Start Imagining's competition is inspired by HM The Queen's Thames Diamond Jubilee Pageant where up to 1,000 boats will journey up the River Thames on 3 June 2012. School children throughout the UK will have the opportunity to create an extraordinary and visionary model of a boat or ship using reclaimed materials.

The winning creations and 5 runner-up entries will form part of a special exhibition to be displayed at the Discover Greenwich centre at the Old Royal Naval College, Greenwich throughout June. The creators of the winning boat will receive a tour of London, culminating in a special visit to the Old Royal Naval College, plus exclusive art kits provided by the specialist Cumbrian pencil company, Derwent.



- There are 2 age groups
  - 5 – 10 year olds
  - 11 -18 year olds
- A winner will be selected from each age group. From these two entries, one overall winner will be selected.
- There will be also 4 runner-up prizes.
- Entries must come from groups of between 2 (minimum) and 6 (maximum) children.
- All models must be a maximum size of 1 metre in any direction.

- All work must be the children's own creations, original and made from reclaimed materials (junk).
- There is no limit to the number of individual entries that can be made.
- Entries must be photographed in focus and in colour.
- Up to 4 images per boat may be included including details or different views.
- To enter, simply upload the images on the 'competition' page of the Start Imagining website.

- The following information should be included:
  - In 'Subject' field: *Either 5-10 or 11-16*
  - In 'Message' field:
    - Class name
    - Teacher name
    - School name
    - Postcode
    - Contact telephone number
- In the case of independent entries please write an adult's name, address, postcode and contact telephone number in the 'Message' field
- The closing date for the Start Imagining competition is **16<sup>th</sup> April 2012**
- The winners will be announced on or around 10<sup>th</sup> May 2012
- The main prize will be awarded in mid-June at a mutually convenient date for both the school and the Start Imagining partners
- The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into
- Unfortunately we cannot return winning boats after they have been on display due to the fragility of the materials. However, the winning boats will be displayed on the Start Imagining website
